This FREE virtual interactive course, offered by the Court and taught by expert mediator and trainer Talin Bahadarian, satisfies the training requirements for the Court's Mediation Volunteer Panel (MVP). The program is MCLE certified by the State Bar for 23.5 hours. Participants will be provided opportunities to gain mediation experience after the training to meet MVP requirements.

Attorneys who apply for this Court-sponsored training must commit to prepare for and conduct a minimum of eight pro bono virtual mediations in a 24-month period following MVP guidelines.

The selection process for participation in the training and serving on the panel includes a qualifying review of application materials and a brief virtual interview.
