HEARINGS (WIC 736.5, 779)

STANDING ORDER


IT IS SO ORDERED that the Division of Juvenile Justice (“DJJ”) will cease operations on June 30, 2023, and a DJJ Jurisdiction Transition Hearing will be set for the youth pursuant to Welfare and Institutions Code Sections 736.5 and 779. The youth will be ordered transferred to the custody of the Probation Department no later than the Thursday of the week immediately preceding the hearing unless otherwise notified by the Court.

The parties shall comply with the following orders:

- DJJ shall file a transition report with the Court no later than 60 calendar days prior to the hearing with copies sent to counsel and the Probation Department upon filing.
- The Probation Department shall file a proposed transition plan with the Court no later than 30 calendar days prior to the hearing with copies sent to counsel upon filing.

- Counsel shall file any moving papers with the Court, including proposed witnesses and exhibits, no later than 10 calendar days prior to the hearing with copies sent to opposing counsel upon filing.
- A waiver of a youth's personal appearance in court and request for remote appearance must be filed in writing with the Court no later than 15 calendar days prior to the hearing.
- The District Attorney's Office shall provide victim notification of the hearing. If the youth is released by DJJ prior to the hearing, the hearing will be vacated without further notice to the parties.
