Upon the filing of a Notice of Conservatee's Death (Judicial Council form GC-399) by the conservator, probate staff are hereby authorized to terminate the conservatorship of the person where there is no conservatorship of the estate provided said notice is submitted on mandatory Judicial Council form number GC-399 (Notice of Conservatee's Death) and executed under penalty of perjury by the conservator as prescribed in Probate Code section 2361 and California Rules of Court rule 7.1052.

Probate staff shall set on the assigned judicial officer's calendar an Order to Show Cause hearing regarding Termination of Supervision of a Conservatorship of a Person when staff become

1 aware of the death of a conservatee other than by the filing of the mandatory Judicial Council form
2 GC-399, including as a result of a Probate investigation.

3 Probate staff shall set an Order to Show Cause hearing upon notice that the Probate
4 Investigator is unable to obtain a Reciprocal Conservatorship Review Report within four (4) months
5 after a request is made, or if there is no designated Probate Investigator in the state or country in
6 which the conservatee resides.

7 Probate staff shall also set an Order to Show Cause hearing upon notice from the Probate
8 Investigator that a conservatee could not be located. The Probate Investigator shall notify staff
9 promptly if a conservatee cannot be located after reasonable diligence by the Probate investigator and
10 in any event no later than four months after such notice.

11 GOOD CAUSE APPEARING, IT IS SO ORDERED.
